- 1. Speakers must approach the podium and microphone and state their name and the town in which they reside for the record.
- 2. Each member of the public may speak <u>one time</u> and for a <u>maximum of three</u> <u>minutes</u>. Each speaker will be timed and must conclude comments when that time is up.
- 3. You may not "borrow" time from another person under any circumstances.
- 4. The purpose of public comment is to hear various perspectives from our community. It is <u>not a two-way dialogue</u>. Board members will not answer questions or directly respond to your statement. Please do not take this as a personal affront as it is protocol.
